RECCE SIGN ON:

Sign on for Recce takes place in The Gleneagle Hotel on the Muckcross Road on Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd of April 2017 from 08.00 to 11.00.

Competition numbers, Road Books, maps etc will be distributed at sign-on.

Competitors found exceeding the limit for any Stage will not be allowed to start, they will forfeit their Entry Fee and will be reported to their ASN. The Club will not accept an Entry from any such Competitor in future events.

Abuse of rally officials including Judges of Fact will not be tolerated and will be dealt with accordingly, remember these people are nonpaid volunteers.

MECHANICAL SCRUTINY:

Mechanical Scrutiny will take place in Killarney Fire Station Bypass Road, Killarney

Time: 14.00 – 20.00 Sharp

No Parking on left hand side of road in coned area.

Only two persons per car allowed in the scrutiny area, this is strictly for insurance reasons.

Competitors who are delayed en-route to scrutiny should contact 086 3772066 to advise on estimated time of arrival.

Trailers should not be brought to the Scrutineering Area at the Fire Station. Cars must be unloaded elsewhere and driven into the Fire Station.

On completion of Mechanical Scrutiny all competitors must hand in their Scrutiny sheets at the rally office Gleneagle Hotel.

TRAILER PARK

Trailer park is located in the grounds of Killarney Race Course, This will be signposted on the when heading out the Muckcross Road. Trailers parked at owners responsibility, The organisers will no take any responsibility for any items lost or stolen. Trailer park gates will be closed and locked from 21.00 each night and will reopen in the morning at 09.00.

No Trailers will be allowed on the Hotel grounds or in the Service Area as space will be limited.

SERVICE AREA

A Single Service Pass can be found in your road book, this must be handed in on Entry to Service area “No Pass – No Entry”

Absolutely No Trailers will be allowed on the Hotel grounds or in the Service Area as space will be limited.

Competitors are reminded that the use of ground sheets is now mandatory on all events.
