





Final Instructions Bulletin no: 1

Firstly Thank you for entering and supporting the 39th Rally of the Lakes 2018.

Recce Sign no: Sign on for Recce takes place on the first floor in The Brehon Hotel, Muckross Road Killarney on Saturday 28th & Sunday 29th of April, Thursday 3rd & 4th of May from 08.00 to 11.00am. (Maximum of 2 days per crew). Reconnaissance from 8:30 to 6pm. All competitors are reminded that they must produce their competition licences and their Name must be on the MI Current list for **IRDS /BRDS**. MSA LICENCE HOLDERS ARE REMINDED THEY MUST ALSO APPLY AND BE LISTED ON THIS LIST.

Competition numbers, Road Books, maps etc will be distributed at sign-on. Recce Numbers must be displayed. In case of any doubt as to exact locations of SAC, Starts, Flying Finish and Stop Controls, please note that the correct location of all these points is as per Road Markings. You are asked to respect the residents when completing your recce on all the stages.

Note: Competitors found exceeding the limit for any Stage will not be allowed to start, they will forfeit their Entry Fee and will be reported to their ASN. The Club will not accept an Entry from any such Competitor in future events.

Abuse of rally officials including Judges of Fact will not be tolerated and will be dealt with accordingly remember these people are unpaid volunteers.

Rally office will be located on the ground floor of the Gleneagle Hotel opposite the reception area from 2pm Friday 4th. Rally office will remain open in Rally HQ for the duration of the event.

PARC FERME: Parc Ferme is in the Lewis Road Car Park and will be available from 2pm on Friday. Security will be in place.

Scrutiny: will take place in Killarney Racecourse - Ross Road (not the fire station as in previous years) · Scrutiny will open at 2pm & close at 7pm sharp. Please ensure you have entered into the correct class.

Trailer Park: will also be in Killarney Racecourse, trailers are parked at owner's risk. No Trailers allowed near the Rally HQ or the service area.

Tyre Trucks & Rally Traders: will be available in the Gleneagle HQ carpark on Friday 4th.

CEREMONIAL START: All Crews are asked to Attend. It will take place at Main Street Killarney on Friday 28th April @19.00. Cars will leave Parc Ferme in seeded order from 18.45hrs and proceed to Main Street (refer to Road Book – Note new route to other years) where they will gather for a welcoming party. No Time Cards required. Cars are to return to Parc Ferme immediately afterwards

Drivers safety briefing: will take place in the Ballroom2 in the Gleneagle Hotel at 7.10am sharp on Saturday 5th. All competitors are requested to attend Drivers briefing, this is mandatory in accordance with the Motorsport Ireland Year book. A random spot check roll call will be taken at drivers briefing.

00 Car Safety briefing: will be held on Friday 4th evening - Meeting outside Rally Office at 8:30pm all crews have to attend (both driver and navigator).

Timecards: will be given out when scrutiny sheets are handed in at documentation Scrutiny - Rally office Gleneagle Hotel HQ. The onus is on each competitor to fill their own competing number on their time cards.

Service Area: A Single Service Pass Sticker is supplied to each crew in their rally pack and must be visual on Entry to each Service area, absolutely No Trailers will be allowed on the Hotel grounds or in the Service Area as space will be limited. Competitors are reminded that the use of ground sheets is now mandatory on all events. A one-way traffic system will be in operation in the service park.

Service crews: can park in the service area at Liebherr Container Crane Factory in Fossa on Saturday the 5th evening from 7pm..

Start Times: will be posted on the notice board & on the results website from 10pm on Friday 4th May and These will also be available at Parc Ferme from 7.30am. Note first car leaving Parc Ferme 8:00 am on Sat and 7:00am on Sunday. Interval Times: Cars will run at 30sec intervals unless advised otherwise.

Final control: into Parcferme is compulsory for all crews.
